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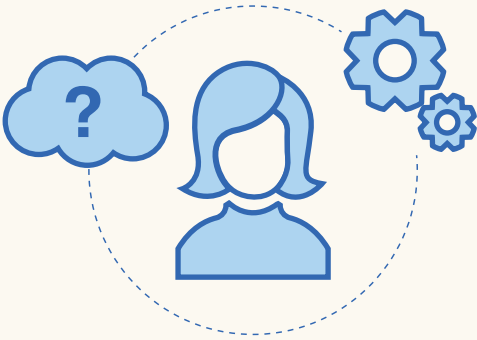

Critical thinking

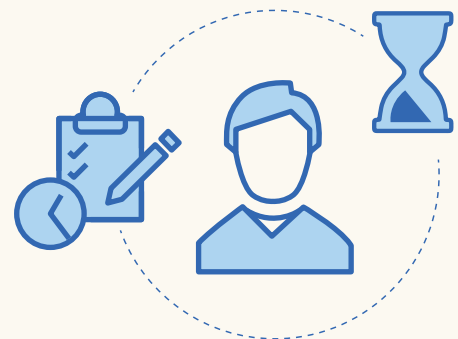
Critical thinking is self-directed, self-disciplined, self-monitored, and self-corrective thinking.

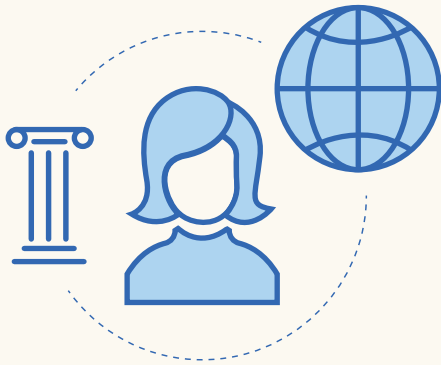
The subject is complex, and several different definitions exist, which generally include the rational, sceptical, unbiased analysis, or evaluation of factual evidence.

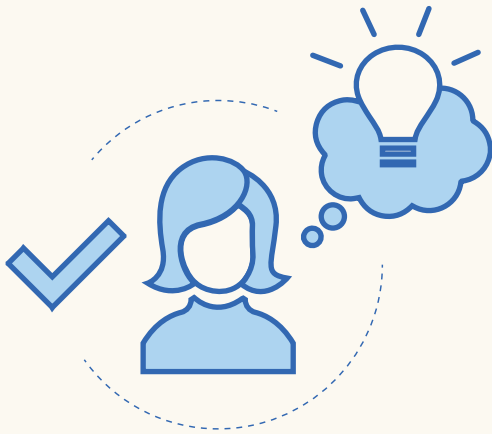


Leadership skills & teamwork

Other leadership traits include honesty, confidence, commitment and creativity.



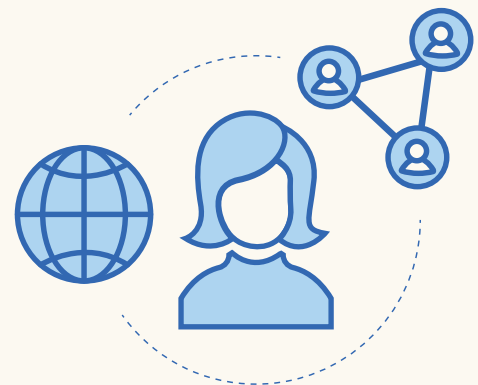
Clarity of thought & presentation

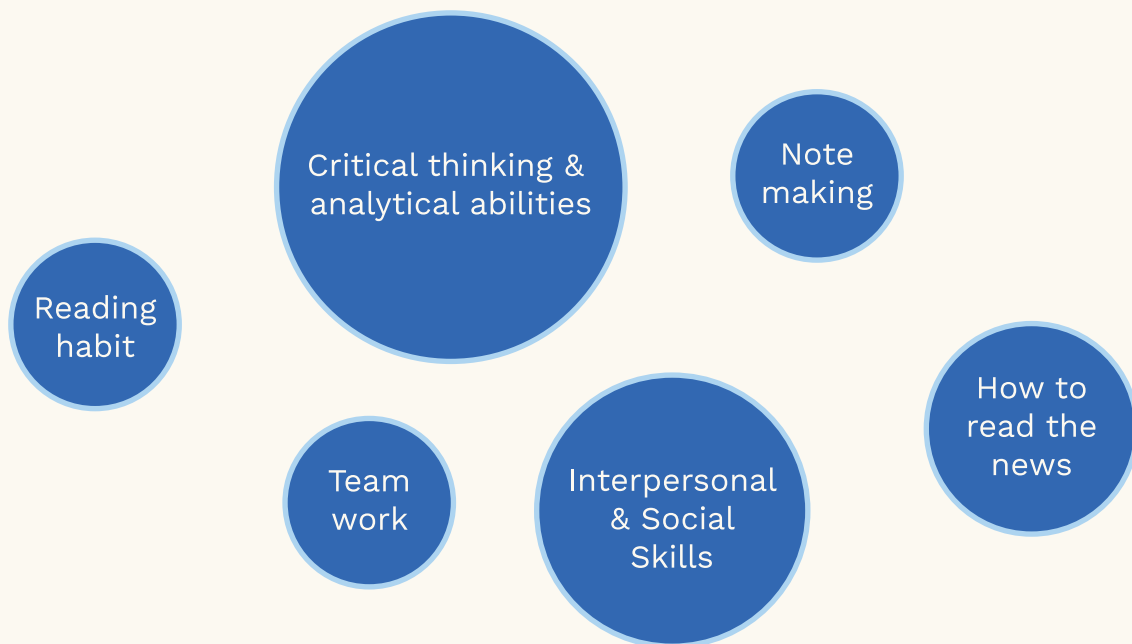
Civil Services Examination tests what you have learnt all your life, and that stresses the need for a solid foundation.
